

The 1199SEIU-League Nurse of Distinction Program

This award program was established as part of the collective bargaining agreement between the 1199 SEIU RN Division and the League of Voluntary Hospitals and Homes. It is one of several initiatives to address the nursing shortage by implementing recruitment and retention programs.

A joint committee of 1199 RN and League members was appointed to oversee the program. The committee developed the criteria for the awards, solicited nominations from institutions and interviewed all the candidates.

Five awards will be presented, recognizing excellence in practice by Registered Nurses and Managers working in 1199 hospitals and nursing homes. The award categories are:

Nurse of Distinction of the Year (hospital setting)
Nurse of Distinction of the Year (nursing home setting)
Nurse Manager of the Year (hospital setting)
Novice Nurse of the Year (hospital setting)
Nurse Preceptor of the Year (hospital setting)

The two Nurse of Distinction Awards are peer-nominated categories. Nurse Manager nominations were made by Staff RNs. Tonight, we honor all nominees, as representatives of professional excellence in their institutions.

ETJSP is a joint effort of 1199SEIU and contributing employers. Our mission is to develop high quality training, placement and labor-management initiatives. Through our efforts we aim to support the potential of healthcare workers to grow educationally and make a full contribution to building an efficient and caring health care industry. We also aim to develop the ability of union and management to problem-solve difficult issues and create innovative solutions. Through our work we intend to create a world-class healthcare workforce and service delivery system.

We believe in the importance of providing appropriate training/educational services for Registered Nurses to enhance their potentials and to uphold quality patient care. In addition, the challenges in the healthcare industry provide opportunities to develop joint labor-management programs and to work with both unionized RNs and healthcare employers to address the needs of our changing industry.

ETJSP established the following RN Funds:

Registered Nurse Training & Job Security Fund (RNTJSF)

The 1199SEIU/League Registered Nurse Training and Job Security Fund was established in 1995 through a collective bargaining agreement between the 1199SEIU RN Divison and contributing institutions from the League of Voluntary Hospitals & Nursing Homes and independent employers.

Quality nursing care is the key to good patient care and recovery. Additional high quality training makes the difference between ordinary and exceptional nursing care.

Benefits for laid-off RNs

Registered Nurse Training & Upgrading Fund (RNTUF)

Established in 1998 in partnership with 1199 SEIU RN Divison, New York State Nurses Association and the League of Voluntary Hospitals & Nursing Homes, the RNTUF administers the Federal Waiver (FW) programs for RNs. The Fund aims to develop, implement and evaluate training/educational programs relevant to the needs of the industry and to upgrade the clinical skills & knowledge of RNs as the industry transitions into the managed care program.

RN Planning & Placement Fund (RNP&P)

The RNP&P was established in the 1998-2001 collective bargaining agreement to develop and administer joint labor-management programs addressing the recruitment and retention of staff RNs and to facilitate the continuous process improvement to make our healthcare industry deliver the highest quality care in New York.

Under the RN Planning & Placement Fund the following five exciting citywide projects have been developed and implemented by labor and management with the goal of improving patient care and increasing recruitment and retention of nurses in member institutions.
