




The Nurse of Distinction Awards program was established by the collective bargaining agreement between the 1199SEIU RN Division and the League of Voluntary Hospitals and Homes to recognize nurses who have made a difference in their profession. Given the continued nursing shortage, this program addresses the retention of nurses working at the bedside.

A joint committee of appointed 1199SEIU RN, League and non-League members oversees the program. The committee develops the criteria for the awards, solicits nominations from institutions and interviews the nominees.






